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1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Preamble

The "13th Rallly Vipavska Dolina 2024" will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) including appendices, the FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations including appendices, the FIA CEZ Championship Regulations, AŠSLO, Austrian Rally challenge regulation and (only when related to national cars) the WADA/NADA Codes, and the FIA AntiDoping Regulations, as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to the Rule s and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins (issued by the Organiser or the Stewards).

The 2024 FIA Regional Rallies Championships Sporting Regulations (FIA RRSR) can be found at www.fia.com. During the rally, for any dispute concerning the interpretation of the regulations, only the English text will be binding.

By signing the entry form a competitor allows to publish the information mentioned in this entry application in media.

4.3 Number of competitors accepted and classes

4.3.1 The number of competitors

The maximum number of competitors will be 100. If more than 100 competitors are entered, the Organiser reserves the sole right to decide which among the non-priority drivers will be accepted.

4.3.3 National Cars and classes

Vehicles from the Art. 12 FIA RRSR, Historic cars with FIA HTP, vehicles with expired FIA homologation or vehicles that are no longer in the list of FIA homologated vehicles (groups A and N, R4, WRC, car kit, GT, up

4.6 Refunds

Entry fee will be refunded in full:

- To candidates whose entry has not been accepted
- In case of the rally not taking place

The organiser may refund part of the entry fee to those competitors who, for reasons of »force majeure« (duly certified by their ASN, before the administrative check) were unable to start the rally. This must be applied for in writing (info@rallyvipavskadolina.si), giving the reason of withdrawal, before the administrative checks, including bank and account details.

5 INSURANCE

5.1 Insurance Coverage for the Organiser

5.1.1 Organiser's liability insurance

The organizer has an insurance policy with Zavarovalnica Triglav d.d. organiser's liability insurance covering damage caused to the third party during the competition up to 1.000.000 €.











5.1.2 Damage caused to the third party

The rally insurance policy of the organizer guarantees competitors to cover damages towards third parties for property and for individuals, but only with competition cars. The insurance cover will come into effect on shakedown and from the start and till the end of the rally or at the moment of permanent retirement, disqualification or exclusion. On the other areas the crews cover damages from their own insurance policy. The organizer does not take any responsibility for the losses and the damages in regard to competitors. The competitors take part in the rally at their own risk.

5.1.3 Insurance policy and International Green Card

All crews will have to submit an administrative check an insurance policy, the crew from abroad as well as international green card for their car. Without it, the crews will not be permitted to take the start.

5.2 Insurance Coverage for the competitors and crews

All the competitors are obliged to arrange their own life accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at administrative check.

By the fact of signing the entry form, the competitors accept the terms from the Supplementary Regulations and relinquishes any rights to compensations of any kind which may occur following the incidents during the rally. This relinquishment concerns the FIA, the AŠSLO (ASN of Slovenia), the Organizer, officials and other competitors.

5.3 Accident Reporting

In case of any accident, the crew or their representative should report this fact to the SOS phone number or control point, respecting the prescriptions of the Accident Procedure (FIA RRSR Art. 53 and Appendix III) and then submit a written report to the Rally HQ as soon as possible.

6 ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1 Advertising

All advertising must comply with the Slovenian law. In Slovenia, the advertising of tobacco and products under tobacco mark is strictly forbidden. The advertising of alcohol drinks has to be in compliance with Slovenian laws. All other advertising provided that:

- it is authorized with national laws and FIA regulations,
- it is not likely to give offence,
- it is not political or religious in nature,
- All other advertising must be in compliance with Art. 29 FIA RRSR,
- it does not interfere with the crew's vision through the window, is allowed to be fixed on the cars.

6.2 Organizer's obligatory advertising

Competitors must reserve the space on the competition car for the organizer's and AŠSLO Advertisings in accordance to Appendix IV. Competitor cannot refuse the organizer's obligatory advertising.

6.3 Organizer's optional advertising

Organizer will require from competitors to carry additional optional advertising in accordance to Appendix IV.

6.4 Loss or removal of advertising

If it is ascertained at any point during the rally that an advertising plate (or any other type of advertisement) supplied by the organizer missing on the car than the crew shall be fined with 350 € for each missing advertisement. Same if the advertisement is not placed according to Appendix IV of these Regulations.











6.5 Rally plates and Competition numbers

Competition numbers and rally plates must be affixed as shown in Appendix IV of these Regulations for the entire duration of the Rally. If it is ascertained at any time during the rally that:

- A missing competition number or rally plate will be penalised with a fine of 100 €.
- If both competition numbers missing will be reported to Stewards.

7 TYRES

7.1 Tyres specified for use during rally

Competitors in National Championships and Mitropa Rally Cup can use tyres complying with the 2023 FIA RRSR and all tyres homologated by FIA since 2013. Tyres can be cut, but tread pattern must be according to manufacturer and Slovenian Road Regulations. Any breach of the tyre regulations will be submitted to the Stewards.

7.2 Tyre for reconnaissance

Tyres used for reconnaissance shall be road-homologated series production tyres.

7.3 National laws

At all times during the rally in Slovenia, the tread depth of the tyres fitted on the car, must not be less than 1,6 mm.

8 FUEL

8.1

Crews must only use fuel in accordance with 2023 Appendix J Art. 252.9. Organizer will not supply competitors with fuel, fuel supply is left to competitor's care. The maximum lead content in fuel permitted in Slovenia is 0,005 g/l.

8.2 Refuelling

Art. 61 FIA RRSR must be respected. Refuelling may only be performed during the rally in the refuelling zones and on petrol stations if they are specified as additional refuelling zones in the Road Book. A maximum of 2 refuellers per competing car are allowed in the refuelling zone at the same time. To access the refuelling zones each service team members must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava and identified with the official passes (Team) supplied by the organizers. According to FIA RRSR Art. 61.2.7 It is required that the crew remain outside the car during refuelling.

9 RECONNAISSANCE

The registration of all recce-cars is compulsory.

9.1 Procedure for registration

The registration for reconnaissance will take place as following:

Date and time: Thursday May 9th 2024; from 12.00 till 18:00

Location: Krajevna skupnost Ajdovščina, Prešernova ulica 26, 5270 Ajdovščina

Date and time: Friday May 10th 2023, from 07:00 till 11:00

Location: Krajevna skupnost Ajdovščina, Prešernova ulica 26, 5270 Ajdovščina











On the registration, the crews must submit information on the vehicle for recce and phone number to be contacted during reconnaissance. Each crew must also submit evidence of paid entry fee. All crews are obliged to attend in person.

9.1.1 Identification numbers

Each crew will receive three numbers for reconnaissance, which must be affixed on a recce-car. One number must appear on the windscreen (the upper middle position), second one on the left rear side window and the third one on the right rear side window, all time during reconnaissance.

9.1.2 Number of persons on board

During each passage through a special stage, the crew (a maximum of 2 persons) are permitted in the car.

9.2 Reconnaissance time schedule

Is set out in Appendix II.

9.3 Reconnaissance rules

The reconnaissance may only be carried out using production cars complying with specifications given in Art. 35 FIA RRSR.

9.3.1 Speed limit

During the reconnaissance crews must strictly observe the prescriptions of the Slovenian Traffic Code. Particularly, they must respect general speed limit in Slovenia of 50 km/h in the built-up area and 90 km/h outside it. Police will control thoroughly the route of special stages and strictly sanction the offenders.

9.3.2 Direction

Crews are forbidden to drive in opposite direction to that of the special stages, except of the route areas specified in the reconnaissance road book.

9.3.3 Restriction of reconnaissance

Any presence of driver or co-driver on the route of special stages in period after the publication of these Supplementary Regulations shall be regarded as reconnaissance performed. Drivers and co-drivers, who for whatever reason enter the area used for 13th Rally Vipavska Dolina during that period, must promptly inform the Clerk of the Course (rallyvipavskadolina@gmail.com), which is also valid for drivers living in that area or working there. Failure to respect this rule shall result in the driver being reported to the Stewards.

9.3.4 Number of passages

The number of passages for each special stage during reconnaissance is not limited, only time schedule must be respected.

9.3.5 Illegal reconnaissance

Reconnaissance outside of the Time Schedule will be regarded as illegal reconnaissance, which will be reported to Stewards. Failure to respect this rule shall result in the driver being reported to the Stewards.

9.3.6 Speeding

Speeding will be penalised in according with Art. 34.2 FIA RRSR.

11 SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

11.1 Scrutineering venue and timetable

Each crew or representative of the team must report to the scrutineering in its individual time, which will be published in a bulletin. Any crew reported as late to scrutineering will be penalized as follows:

Up to 30 min 50,00 € 30 – 60 min 100,00 €

Over 60 min according to the decision of the Stewards

Priority on the scrutineering timetable will have crews that will be taking part to the shakedown. The competition cars must come to the scrutineering with rally plates, competition numbers and organizer's advertising already affixed to the car. Car can be brought to the scrutineering by a team member with a written permission from the competitor. At scrutineering, if a car is found not in compliance with technical, safety or other regulations, the Stewards may set a deadline to have the car complying with these regulations, or the Stewards will refuse the crew to start. Scrutineering will be in accordance with FIA RRSR. At scrutineering, all competitors must present their car together with the supplementary headlight bank, which they will use during the rally.

11.2 Mud flaps

Mud flaps can be used in accordance with Appendix J Article 252.7.7.

11.3 Windows/Nets

Use of tinted windows is authorized in accordance with Article 253.11 "Windows/nets" of Appendix J of the FIA International Sporting Code.











11.4 Driver's safety equipment

Competitors helmets (which must comply with the requirements of FIA Appendix L), FHR devices (which must be an FIA approved model as detailed in Technical List No.29 of Appendix J) and flame-resistant clothing (homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard) will be checked at scrutineering.

11.5 Noise level

All cars must be equipped with stable exhaust silencer. The outside noise level measured by stationary method may not exceed 103 dB/A with margin of error \pm 1dB/A. The noise level will be measured at distance of 50 cm from exhaust outlet with angle of 45 degrees. The noise level must be measured at 3500 revs/min for petrol engine cars and at 2500 revs/min for diesel engine cars.

11.6 Installation of Safety Tracking System

Instalment of rented GPS tracking equipment is mandatory in order to participate to 13. Rally Vipavska dolina 2024. Details can be found in appendix V. of this supplementary regulations.

12 OTHER PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

12.1 Start procedure on Special Stages (Electronic start procedure) except Super Special Stage 1

The electronic start procedure is as follows:

- 1. Starting lights will be in use, placed on the right side of the road, 3 to 5 meters after the starting line.
- 2. At 30 seconds to go a yellow light will illuminate.
- 3. At each of the last five seconds before the start red lights illuminates.
- 4. The crew start, when all five red lights go out.

A photocell trap placed approx. 50 cm after the starting line will be used to detect jump starts. If electronic devices fail to start, the starting procedure will be given by hand, as specified in Art. 48.3 FIA RRSR.

12.3 Finish procedure

12.3.1 There will be a specific finish procedure

The final time control will be 10C (Cilj - Finish). From here competitors will be required to follow the route indicated in road book, under Parc Ferme conditions directly to Parc Ferme.

12.3.2 Availability of participants

Participants who park their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, must remain available by phone (mobile) until the final classification has been posted.

12.3.3 Classification

The final classification will not be distributed after the event. The final classification will be published on Sportity app Password is **RVD24.**

12.4 Permitted early check in

Competitors may report before their due time, without incurring a penalty, at the following time controls:

TC 1B Service Out TC 10A Holding are IN

TC 1C Parc Ferme In TC 10C Finish











12.5 Super Special Stage 1

12.5.1 Start system for Super Special Stage (SSS1)

- 1. Starting lights will be placed in the driver's field of vision
- 2. At first the light will be red
- 3. Starter will show with hand approximately 5 seconds before the start. After 5 seconds, the light will turn on green, which means the crew can start.
- 4. The crew can start within 5 seconds after the green light turns on, in case a crew does not start because of their own fault within 5 seconds, the crew will have one additional try to start. If the crew does not start the second time it will be refused to start the SSS.
- 5. To calculate the liaison it will be used the WRITTEN ACTUAL TIME OF THE START (start will be measured by photocell!!)

12.5.2 Failure to complete SSS 1

That a crew has failed to complete SSS will be considered under the following conditions:

- Crew has started the Rally on TC 0, has left the control area but has not started on SSS 1,
- Crew has started on SSS1 but has not driven the prescribed minimum number of circles,
- Crew has started on SSS1 but fails to complete the stage or retires after completing SSS1 and fails to deliver the car to parc ferme.

In such a case, the rules according 55 FIA RRSR must be followed, and the crew is allowed to re-start in the Section 2 of LEG 1. If the crew completes more circles than minimum prescribed, the time achieved will be the time taken on SSS1.

12.5.3 Penalty for not completing SSS

To any crew that will fail to complete SSS1 (point 12.5.2), a time penalty of the fastest time in his class plus 10 minutes will apply.

12.6 Special procedures and activities

12.6.1 Shakedown

Competitors which would like to participate on Shakedown, have to register for it and pay a fee of 100€. Shakedown will take place on Friday 10th of May 2024 from 12:00 to 15:00.

12.6.2 Tire warming zone (TWZ)

Tire warming zone in accordance with article 44.4 FIA RRSR will not be arranged.

12.7 Official Rally time is official GPS time, time zone in Slovenia in May is CEST (UTC +2).

12.8 Re-start after retirement

For the crews, which will not be able to complete the LEG 1 Section 1, the rules according 55 FIA RRSR must be followed and the crew is allowed to re-start in the LEG 1 Section 2. Any crew which has failed to complete LEG 1 Section 1 and will not re-start the rally on LEG 1 Section 2, needs to confirm this in writing to clerk of the course at least thirty minutes before the publication of Start list for LEG 1 Section 2.

12.8.1 Parc ferme for retired competition cars

Organizer will establish a parc ferme for retired cars. Competitors/Organiser have to/will bring car into parc ferme after retiring. Cars will be released after inspection by the scrutineers.











12.9 Service procedures

A limitation for servicing, refuelling and changes of mechanical parts is in FIA RRSR. Service Park can be entered only with Service car (SERVICE).

12.10 Service park

12.10.1 Allocation of working areas

In the service park competitors may only use a space allocated by the organizer by the following criteria:

- to each FIA priority driver will be allotted an area of 100 m²
- to each driver with ASN priority 60 m²
- all other drivers 50m²

If crew wishes additional space, it can be bought for 50 €/m². Crews must inform the organizer in written form about that until Monday May 6th 2024 (*info@rallyvipavskadolina.si*).

12.10.2 Speed limit Art. 57.4 FIA RRSR

Speed limit imposed in Service Park, for all vehicles including the competition cars, is 30 km/h. Speeding will be penalized according to Art. 57.4 FIA RRSR.

12.10.3 Behaviour within the service park

During servicing and repairing a protective coating impermeable to oil and petrol in the size of the competition car plus 0,50 m on each side must be placed under the car. After servicing, service place must be cleaned. This rule will be supervised by marshals. In case of infringement, especially soiling the Service Park, the Clerc of the Course will penalize the crew with a fine of 500 €. If during Service works must be done, which threats safety in Service Park (for example fire) competitor must inform marshals in Service Park to organize all safety procedures according to assure necessary safety measures. Each service vehicle must have at least one 6 kg fire extinguisher. Control will be performed at the entrance into the Service Park. During servicing it must be placed on a visible and easily reachable place, not near vessels with inflammable ingredient. The use of glowing tools is allowed only if accompanied by appropriate personnel and equipment to prevent fire. All crews (each starting number) must pay to organizer a 100 € deposit before entering the service area for possible cost of cleaning the service park. After leaving the service park after the rally the organizer will refund the deposit to all crews which will adequately clean the surface that they were using.

15 FINAL CHECKS

15.1 Final checks

Any teams required to undergo final scrutineering must immediately follow the instruction of the marshals in charge, even if this prevents them from proceeding to one or more time controls (TC). The complete original FIA homologation form and other necessary certifications must be available for final scrutineering. A representative of the competitor as well as mechanics with the appropriate tools (in case of dismantling) must be present at the final scrutineering. The final checks will start on Saturday May 11th 2024 approx. 18:30 hour.

15.2 Protest deposit fees

Sum of the protest deposit is set to 300,00 EUR by national AŠ 2005.

- The competitor against whom the protest has been lodged if it is upheld.

Part of the SHAKEDOWN is partially running in the opposite direction as HP 3,6,9 the reconnaissance can take place only on Thursday May 9th 2024 from 18:20 till 20:00 and Friday from 07:00 till 08:00. Due to safety reason, it is strictly forbidden to do the reconnaissance of SS 3,6 and 9 in this time.

As parts of the super special stage are driven in the one way streets in the opposite direction, the reconnaissance can be done only on foot!

Reconnaissance of the super special stage 1 with Chicanes already in place can be done on foot on Friday May 10th 2024 from 16:00 till 17:00.

We warn the competitors that any kind of practice on the rally route is strictly forbidden. For the people, who live on the route, rally and particularly reconnaissance, when the road is open for a normal traffic, present a major increase of traffic and a major disturbance in their habits of life. Thus, people are often against rally and organizer has to put huge effort to get their permission. Reconnaissance out of the prescribed terms and racing on the route threat the future rallies. For this reason, we appeal to the crews to respect reconnaissance restrictions. The organizer, together with the local Police, will control thoroughly the route of special stages and strictly sanction the offenders.






APPENDIX IV – COMPETITION NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING

Competitors must reserve the space on the competition car for the rally plates, competition numbers and organizer's advertising in accordance to pictures.

A₁: Driver and Codriver name with her/his national flag of the ASN from which she/he obtained her/his licence. Font type Helvetica, font colour white. First letter in Upper case the rest in lower case, dimensions: 6 cm, with stroke width 1.0 cm.

B: 2 front door panels measuring 67 cm wide by 17 cm high including a 1 cm white surround. Each of these panels shall comprise a 15 cm x 15 cm competition number box which shall always be at the front of the panel Numerals will be fluorescent yellow (PMS 803), 14 cm high and with a stroke width of 2 cm, on a matt black background. The remainder of the door panel is reserved for the use of the organiser. Each panel shall be placed horizontally at the leading edge of each front door, with the number at the front. The top of the plate shall be between 7 cm and 10 cm below the lower limit of the window. No signage, other than the colour scheme of the car, shall be placed within 10 cm of the panel.

C: organizer's mandatory advertising











SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

D: numbers for each rear side window which shall be 25 cm high with a stroke width of at least 25 mm, coloured fluorescent orange (PMS 804), and may be reflective. These numbers shall be placed at the top of the rear side windows in conjunction with the driver's name

E: one rally plate fitting into a rectangle 43 cm wide by 21.5 cm high which shall include the competition number

G: An adjacent area of 15 cm² shall contain the fluorescent orange (PMS 804) 14 cm high competition number on a clear background. This number may be reflective and must be visible from the rear at eye level.











APPENDIX V - GPS tracking

The Mireo GPS tracking device is designed to track the movements of competitive vehicles for the duration of Rally for safety reasons.

Competitors pick up the device during the "Verification" with a driver's license deposit, and at the time and place specified by the race organizer as the "Special Competition Regulations".

Installation of the device is carried out in the "SERVICEA ZONE" and is carried out by the competitors themselves or their mechanics. In case competitors do not have a connector model used to connect Mireo GPS devices (Fig. 2), they can get them from the Mireo operator for an additional cost of 5€.

During the competition switch on the Mireo GPS device (fig. 1.), must be in position "0". If there is a need for intervention (firefighters, emergency medical attention), the switch is switched to position "1" (SOS), and in the HQ Rally, an "SOS ALARM" is activated with the starting number of competitors and its position on the speed test (BI/SS) or stage.

During the race, the return of the device will take place at the HQ Rally, within the estimated time set by the organizer. This applies to competitors who have missed or completed the competition for any reason.

Other competitors return the devices after the finish, in the final parc ferme, unless the organizer decides otherwise.

INSTALL MIREO GPS DEVICES

When connecting the device, only connector (Fig. 2) is used, with a marked polarity (+/-).

- connect the Mireo GPS device directly to the vehicle battery of the 12 V;
- place the device on a protective cage with a number box up (Fig. 3) and attach it to plastic bindings, except in cases approved by operator Mirea GPS when controlling functionality at technical reception.
- control of the functionality of the Mireo GPS device, is carried out during the "technical inspection" at the time and at the designated place provided by the organizer.

For non-compliance with the installation instructions, due to which the Miro GPS device (incorrectly connected +/-) was replaced or by returning the damaged device, the fee is charged 100 € in cash and immediately pays the operator Mirea GPS.



Mireo GPS position



BNC connector for connection Mireo GPS system for RALLY CONTROL



APPENDIX VI - Austrian Rally Challenge

Authorized vehicles
